Criteria 'B' List

For persons whom the Eurasier Society UK would support to judge the breed at Open Shows or Championship shows without CC's where there are more than 3 classes.

To have 5 years experience of exhibiting, breeding and handling a Nordic or Asiatic spitz breed	To have had a minimum 5 years judging experience and 8 years of exhibiting, breeding or handling the candidate's own breed.
To have judged at over 3 KC licensed shows with a geographical spread a minimum of 20 Eurasiers	To have judged at over 3 KC licensed shows with a geographical spread a minimum of 10 Eurasier and 10 Nordic or Asiatic spitz type dogs
To have attended a ESUK breed specific seminar and passed an assessment on the Breed Standard (where applicable) or attended an Eurasier Breed Appreciation Day	To have attended a ESUK breed specific seminar and passed an assessment on the Breed Standard (where applicable) or attended an Eurasier Breed Appreciation Day
Can prove a depth of interest in the breed	Can prove a depth of interest in the breed

Additionally for applicants not already awarding Challenge certificates in any breed:

- To have stewarded on at least 6 occasions
 - To have attended at least one seminar given by a KC accredited trainer & passed the relevant examination for:
 - a) *Requirements of a Dog Show judge within the last 5 years*
 - b) *Conformation & Movement*
 - c) *Hands on Practical Assessment.*
