

Criteria 'B' List

For persons whom the Eurasier Society UK (provisional) would support to judge the breed at Open Shows or Championship shows without CC's where there are more than 3 classes.

Breed Specialist	Non-Breed Specialist
To have 5 years experience of exhibiting, breeding or handling a Spitz breed	To have had a minimum 5 years judging experience and 5 years of exhibiting, breeding or handling the candidate's own breed.
To have judged a minimum of 10 Eurasiers at Open or Championship shows	To have judged a minimum of 15 Eurasier and/or ? Chow Chow, Keeshond or Samoyed at Open or Championship shows
To have attended a ESUK breed specific seminar and passed an assessment on the Breed Standard (where applicable)	To have attended a ESUK breed specific seminar and passed an assessment on the Breed Standard (where applicable) An exception can be made for group judges for a limited time
Can prove a depth of interest in the breed	Can prove a depth of interest in the breed

Additionally for applicants not already awarding Challenge certificates in any breed:

- To have stewarded on at least 4 occasions •
- To have attended at least one seminar given by a KC accredited trainer & passed the • relevant examination for:

- a) Requirements of a Dog Show judge
- b) Conformation & Movement
- c) Hands on Practical Assessment.
